Transfer Coursework Review

Arkansas State University will review transfer work completed while on a first suspension only after the student returns and successfully completes 12 hours with a 2.00 GPA, as well as the Restart@state program (if required). No more than 12 credit hours of coursework completed at another accredited college or university while on a first academic suspension from A-State will be considered for transfer and only if the coursework:

- 1. removes deficiencies, such as the required high school core or developmental coursework; and/or
2. is retaken per the A-State repeat policy (retaking coursework earned at A-State with a grade below "C"); and/or
3. is designated by A-State as 1000- or 2000-level.

NOTE: No credit hours earned at other institutions during a period in which the student is on mandatory second, third, or subsequent suspension from A-State will be accepted for transfer by Arkansas State University.
